Once this step has been completed, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any extensive wear, any defects or breakage. Specific parts like for instance crankshafts, cylinder blocks, connecting rods and cylinder heads are reground, resurfaced and resized if considered necessary. Several parts like nuts, bolts, gears and all that. are replaced or repaired as considered necessary.
