

Cascade Clamps

Cascade Clamp - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first hiring 4 people. Sales for their initial year of operation totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and various components. During 5 years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is among the top worldwide manufacturers in the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new company to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. Throughout the last 60 years, the industry of material handling has developed into a very complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the best provider of forklift accessories and numerous related products. The business feels certain in their potential so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive within the international market.

Throughout the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to make, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A brand new facility was built in the year 1956, so as to house all plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which remains to be the company's present head office. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total staff reached a hundred and eighty workers and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, Berkeley the next production plant was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company recognized interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the U.S. with areas in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Berkeley. Cascade products are fabricated globally because of a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is designed to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the impressive acquisition of five firms, together with the global leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
